Rossdales Equine Hospital and Diagnostic Centre is approached from the A14, turning off at the A142 Ely and Newmarket junction. Turn off the slip road in the direction of Ely. Light traffic can turn left after 100 yards along Windmill Hill (signposted Exning) into the village of Exning. At the top of Windmill Hill is the War Memorial crossroads and just before the junction, turn right into Cotton End Road. The hospital entrance is located a few hundred yards along the road on the left hand side. If Windmill Hill is closed, keep going straight, turn left at the next roundabout and follow this lane until you find Rossdales on the right.
